



This document explains how to install your system's optional RAID on motherboard (ROMB) card. Your upgrade kit includes the ROMB card, RAID software, and RAID software documentation

- NOTICE: To avoid possible data loss, back up all data on the hard drives before changing the mode of operation of the integrated SCSI controller from SCSI to RAID.
- NOTE: The ROMB card supports only SCSI drives connected to the internal SCSI backplane, or external SCSI drives in a Dell<sup> $^{\text{TM}}$ </sup> PowerVault<sup> $^{\text{TM}}$ </sup> 2xx storage enclosure.



### **Before You Begin**

NOTICE: Before installing the ROMB card, you must update your BIOS to the latest version.

Before shutting down your system prior to installing the ROMB card, you must perform these preliminary steps to ensure system compatibility with the new card:

- **1** Record the system configuration settings.
- **2** Update the BIOS.

#### **Record the System Configuration**

View the system configuration screens in the System Setup program and make a record of these settings. See the system's *User's Guide* for instructions on using the System Setup program.

#### Update the BIOS

Update your system with the latest version of the BIOS, available at the Dell | Support website at support.dell.com.

## Installing the ROMB Card

- 1 Turn off the system, including any attached peripherals, and disconnect the system from the electrical outlet.
- **2** Open the system doors (see "Opening the System Doors" in your system *Installation* and Troubleshooting Guide).
- **3** Locate the ROMB card connector on the system board (see Figure 1-1).
- 4 Align the edges of the ROMB card with the three plastic standoffs on the system board and lower the card onto the system board (see Figure 1-1).
  - When the card is fully seated, the three plastic standoffs snap over the card's edge.
- **5** Secure the ROMB card with the thumbscrew (see Figure 1-1).
- **6** Ensure that the ROMB battery (see Figure 1-1) is connected to the ROMB card. If necessary, connect the ROMB battery cable.
- /N CAUTION: Replace the ROMB card battery only with the same or equivalent type recommended by the manufacturer. Discard used batteries according to the manufacturer's instructions. See your System Information document for additional information.
  - **7** Close the system covers.
  - **8** Reconnect the system and peripherals to their power sources, and turn them on.
  - **9** Enter the System Setup program and verify that the setting for the SCSI controller has changed to reflect the presence of the RAID hardware (see "Using the System Setup Program" in your *User's Guide*).
- **10** Configure RAID arrays on the SCSI hard drives (see the software documentation provided with the ROMB card for more information).
