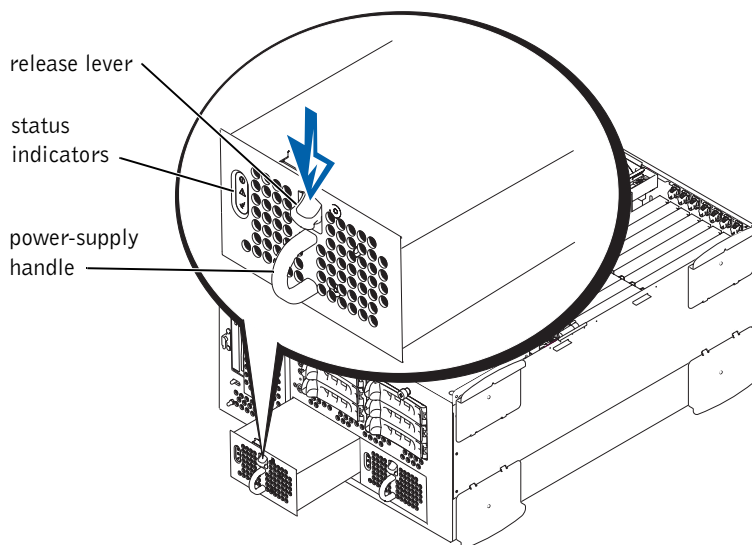
To upgrade your system with a single power supply to a fully redundant configuration with two hot-pluggable power supplies, you must remove the plastic plug from the secondary power connector at the back of the system, connect a power cable to the secondary power connector, and install an additional hot-pluggable power supply.

- 1 Unpack the redundant power supply customer kit.
- 2 Open the bezel.
- 3 Use a plastic, flat-tip screwdriver to remove the plastic cover over the unoccupied power supply bay on the front panel.
- 4 Insert the power supply into the unoccupied front-panel bay until it clicks in place (see Figure 1-1).

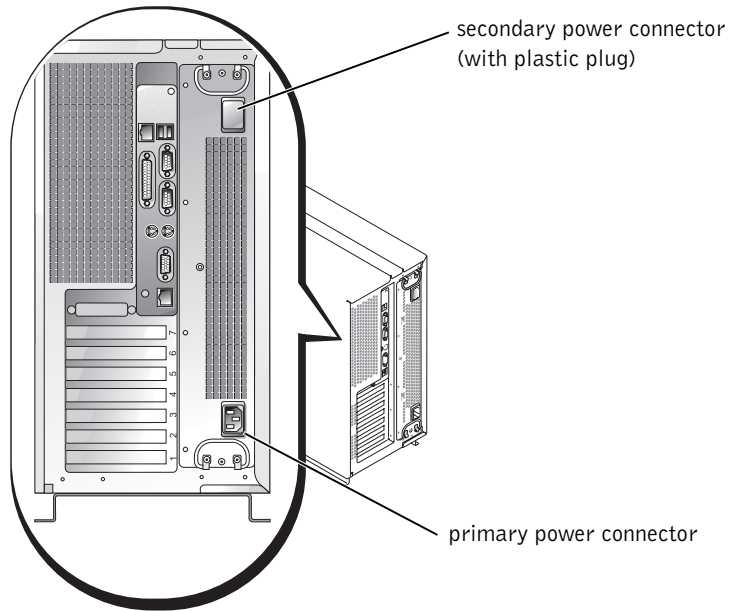
✎ NOTE: After installing a new power supply, allow several seconds for the system to recognize the power supply and determine whether it is working properly. The round power-on indicator turns green to indicated that the power supply is functioning properly (see Figure 1-1).

- 5 Close the bezel.
- 6 Remove the plastic plug from the secondary power connector by pulling the tab (see Figure 1-2).

- 7 Connect the power cable supplied with your kit to the secondary power connector.
- 8 Connect the power cable to a known good AC power source.
